



### **The O Putter - A Solid Investment**

With new putter designs hitting the courses everyday, golfers are becoming accustomed to seeing unique and sometimes bizarre designs in play on the course. Some of these new putter introductions include the Titleist Futura, Hogan Big Ben and Taylor Made Monza, to name a few. The unique O Putter positions itself as the high performance putter with the unique ability to pick the ball out of the cup without bending down to get it yourself. This is obviously a good thing for anyone that has had a bad back or other physical ailments that make scooping made putts out of the cup.

### **Golfdoggy's Review**

**Feel and Sound** - A+ The putter feels very solid - not too solid or harsh -and pleasant sound at impact. This is probably the most outstanding feature of the putter. This is what you pay for, in my opinion. Solid through impact with a pleasing ring when the ball is struck.

**Appearance** - Different, but who is to say that different is a bad thing. Look at the Futura, Hogan or Taylor Made, they are all pushing the design envelope. Investment cast in a unique shape with weighted "wings" on top moves the center of gravity up on the putter face, placing a nice roll on the ball. The unique O on the sole, in addition to being able to pick balls up, distributes the weight away from the putters axis to provide additional heel and toe weighting.

**Construction** - Excellent, all materials used in the putter are outstanding. The putter head is cast and finished with a very nice polished finish.

**Set Up** - Ball alignment is easy with the dominant white line cut on the top line and then extending through the back ring.

**Results:** The putter is rock solid. I found the putter to be quite forgiving on putts that were struck near the toe and heel.

Overall - Unique design, excellent feel and construction. Regardless if you have a need or not for assistance in retrieving your ball without having to bend down for it, the O Putter is a solid investment.
