THIS PUTTER IS A GREAT PICKUP

Several recent rounds using the O Putter leave Fairway & Greens testing team with some general, favorable observations.

First, and most obviously, is the “O” in the O Putter. You may call it gimmicky – perhaps it is – but it may be the most practical gimmick in golf. Gone is the need for the unceremonious squat or bend to retrieve your ball from the cup (or close to the cup with a lip-out or gimme). This is where the “O” comes in. Simply press the putterhead down on top of the ball- even at the bottom of the cup – and lift it effortlessly up and out. It also cups the ball nicely from underneath if you choose to “scoop and swing” the ball off the turf.

For actual putting, the O Putter is as solid as any flatstick we’ve used. Tall in the face and solid as an anvil, nothing else makes the sound the O Putter does. Somewhere between the bell tone of Big Ben and the report of an aluminum bat pounding out a line drive, its pleasing and reassuring and may also come in handy if an angry bear wanders onto your fairway.

The O Putter rolls the ball truly, solidly and reliably. While we enjoy it for its entertainment factor, we also appreciate the convenience every time we don’t have to bend down to retrieve the ball. Great for older golfers with back, hip or knee problems, the O Putter is a functional, quality product with a gimmick that makes perfect sense for any player with a garage-ful of short game clubs.
