

### **Good with many great features**

When we were asked by our readers about The O Putter, we had not heard about it. Now we have tested it.

This putter is a little heavier than most putters. The head weighs 350 grams. It has a small face with low loft and is top weighted in the head to create top-spin which leads to a better roll.

The target line behind the hole in the head is a very good solution to one of the biggest problems most people have with putting – aiming straight.

The O Putter feels similar when striking the ball to the very good and more expensive Scotty Camron putter, which has become so popular – especially among better golfers. There is great balance in The O Putter which is face balanced.

### **More than just a putter:**

**In addition to being a very good putter it has a couple of very practical features in its design. You can sink your putt and sink the putter into the cup to retrieve the ball without bending because the ball gets stuck in the “O” with only very light pressure onto the ball. In addition you can use the back of the putter head to pick up the flag from the green and/or another club that you might have left lying on the green. You would need to find the equilibrium of what you are picking up. This is easy after a couple of tries!**

The inventor is an older gentleman with a low handicap who probably has a bad back – if we should guess from the great design. These will increase in numbers as the years go by.
